In 2015, the KBC produced their 1st “Throwback to Give Back” Concert. It was a tremendously successful show. In addition to the annual concerts, KBC produced smaller monthly Throwback Pop Up shows. Thus far, the Club has helped fifteen friends with compromised health.
